| Applicant Qualification | ①Applicants must be overseas students and are required to have graduated (or will graduate by March, 2026) from high school overseas. ②Applicants must be overseas students who have completed twelve years of formal education, or who will complete twelve years of formal education as of March, 2026 and will be 18 years of age by April 1st, 2026. ③Applicants who are recognized by Hanazono University as having equivalent qualifications to those above Applicants are required to have Japanese proficiency to understand courses conducted in Japanese. Applicants must meet one of the three qualifications above and have taken the EJU (Japanese language): Examination dates on and after May 2024: June 16th, 2024, November 10th, 2024, June 15th, 2025, November 9th, 2025 | |
